

Cold-Mount® Hand Operated Presses



Coda's Cold-Mount® hand operated presses perform a wide variety of mounting tasks, from simple pressure sensitive mounting to overlaminating. These presses are available in widths of 14", 26", and 34".

Coda, Inc. is known as the firm that first offered pressure sensitive mounting and laminating to the photographic and graphic arts industries. Coda drew on this extensive experience when these presses were originally designed in 1986.

These machines feature separate adjustments for material thickness and roller pressure. The first adjusts the space between the rollers, up to 2" wide. The press design incorporates a second adjustment that controls the pressure exerted by the rollers. This is achieved by varying the compression of springs that "load" the top roller of the press. This feature is particularly important when using overlaminate films, which need considerably more pressure than simple mounting. This design also provides consistent pressure even when the thickness of boards being used varies.

The presses are available with either rubber or silicone coated rollers. Exposed adhesive will not adhere to silicone rollers. They also have a longer useful life than standard rubber rollers. Both types of rollers are of equal hardness and will successfully perform a wide variety of mounting and laminating tasks.

The extensive use of this design in the field has proven itself over and over again under the demanding conditions of real world day to day operation. We have also used this experience to make a number of improvements to the design of the press assuring that our new presses are the most durable and reliable units we have ever offered.

The Coda Cold-Mount® press can be used to:

- Mount photographs to standard mount boards, plexi, wood, formica, etc. using Cold-Mount® Adhesive.
- Mount photographs and graphics to the Coda line of Cold-Mount® boards which are precoated with pH neutral Cold-Mount® Adhesive.
- Apply Coda's protective films, Overlam, to the front surface of photographs.
- Mount heat-sensitive prints to a variety of substrates.
